

Coyote Point Summer Biathlon

29 April 2007

REGISTRATION:

Due to insurance requirements, athletes must be a member of USBA (one day memberships can be obtained), at least 14, and must complete a mandatory pre-race safety clinic. Pre-registration fee for the race is \$22 until April 28, 2007. Race day entry fee is \$25. Make race checks payable to **Allen Takahashi**, Summer Biathlon. Entry fee includes clinic, use of equipment, ammunition, ear plugs, T-shirt, refreshments and awards. Entry fees are not refundable. We race rain or shine. There is a \$4 fee to enter the park which gives you access to parking, (cold) showers, and the public beach. We have a tight schedule at the range - all .22 shooting must be completed by 10 am so the number of entrants may be restricted. **Note:** If you have them bring safety glasses and ear plugs as they are required in the range. Shared safety glasses will be available if you do not have them. For the safety of participants baby joggers/strollers, bicycles, roller skates/blades, pets, etc. are not be permitted on the course during the race.

START TIME: Registration of

Registration opens at 7 am. Mandatory Clinic and rifle zero start at 7:30am. Race starts promptly at

8:40 a.m. Sunday, April 29, 2007.

CLINIC: All first-time participants are required to attend a pre-race biathlon familiarization clinic. At the clinic

you will learn the rules of the sport, correct shooting positions, safety procedures, and race strategy.

The familiarization clinic will start promptly at 7:30 a.m. on race day.

AWARDS: Prizes will be awarded to the first three men and women in each age group, and if there is time for a

shoot-out, an award for the top shooter.

FEATURES: Picnic facilities with views of San Francisco bay are available. Public beach, wind surf facilities,

Natural History museum and showers in the park. Micro brewery and restaurants nearby.

<u>DIRECTIONS</u>: Event takes place at Coyote Point Rifle & Pistol Club range. From 101 North, take the Dore Avenue

exit and immediately turn left on Bayshore. Proceed to Coyote Point Drive - just before the overpass, enter the park and follow the signs to the shooting range. From 101 South, take the Poplar Avenue exit and go straight to the first signal light. Turn right onto N. Humbolt St. Proceed to the next light and turn right again on Peninsula Ave. Go over the overpass and make an immediate left; go under the overpass and make a left on Coyote Point Drive. Enter the park and follow the signs to the shooting
